Dear Diabetes Testing Supply and Insulin Syringe Manufacturer:

The State of Missouri, MO HealthNet Division (MHD) is continuing the Diabetic Supply Preferred Drug List (PDL) annual evaluation process. The Division is reviewing diabetic supply products and seeking supplemental rebate offers for maximum cost effectiveness for the MO HealthNet Pharmacy Program. Preferred diabetic supply products will be chosen based on effectiveness and the relative cost net of supplemental rebates. The effective dates of the contracts for selected products will be from April 01, 2023 through March 31, 2024. All Offers from manufacturers are due:

5:00 p.m. EST on Friday, October 14th, 2022.

Rebates will begin to accrue on April 1st, 2023 for those diabetic supplies chosen as preferred. Diabetic supplies being solicited include, but are not limited to blood glucose/ketone meters, lancets, lancet devices, blood and urine glucose and ketone testing strips, Continuous Glucose Monitors, insulin syringes, pen needles, smart pen devices, tubeless insulin pumps and other products used in the testing and/or administration of diabetic treatments that manufacturers wish to submit offers for consideration on.
